After some discussion over some errors Clerk Woodruff read the title and Monica Clark made the motion to accept once corrections were made and Matt Smith seconded. It passed 8-0




Nick Davis spoke to the council about an additional charge on the cable bills and after some discussion Mayor Jones stated he would get with our cable representative and see what could be done.
