

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
MAY 24, 2016**

The City Council of the City of Nashville met on Tuesday, May 24, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chamber for the regular monthly meeting.

Presiding Officer Mayor Billy Ray Jones called the meeting to order.

Jimmy Dale led the Council in prayer.

Dale Pierce led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call, all members were present with the exception of Vivian Wright. Others in attendance were Nashville News, SW Arkansas Radio, The Leader, Wendy Harris, Jimmy Dale, Larry Dunaway, and City Clerk Woodruff.

Joe Hoen made a motion to accept the minutes and was seconded by Jimmie Lou Kirkpatrick. There were 11 yeas and 0 nays.

Jimmy Dale presented financials and explained the extraordinary expenses. We are still waiting on the FEMA money. With there being no questions Carol Mitchell made a motion to accept the financials with a second by James Parker. There were 11 yeas and 0 nays.

Public Works Director, Larry Dunaway told the Council that all the paperwork for Phase 1 of the sidewalk project has been turned in and that Resolution 2016-05 is the last bit of paperwork needed for Phase 2. Resolution 2016-05 was read by Clerk Woodruff, which is the 2nd resolution in regards to the sidewalk project. Monica Clark made a motion to approve the resolution with Carol Mitchell giving the 2nd. It passed 11 – 0. Next Larry told the council that all paperwork on the water project has been completed and turned in. He said that there was going to be \$30,000.00 plus bills coming in payable to Advanced Intergraded Services which is the company that takes care of our SCADA system. He told the members that Nashville Rural Water would be paying 50% of this bill. He gave the members an update on future paving and stated at current he has approximately 22,000 feet of streets listed.

Park Director Wendy Harris gave the Council an overview of upcoming events and activities. She stated the concessions made \$7,009.00 during the tournament over the May 21-22 baseball tournament. Dinofest has 33 baseball teams signed up and 30 for the 5K run. Tyson's paid for a new scoreboard on the Tyson field.


Chief Pierce told the council that our new dog, Apollo has made 9 good drug cases in 2 weeks. He stated that there were no problems to report and that all was going well at the department.


Jerry Harwell gave a brief update for the fire department and code enforcement. He stated for the first time in his 25 years of service there were no fires in April. He issued 4 permits and that if anyone had a complaint to please have them call him.
