

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
JANUARY 24, 2017**

The City Council of the City of Nashville met on Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chamber for the regular monthly meeting.

Presiding Officer Mayor Billy Ray Jones called the meeting to order and led the Council in prayer. Chief Dale Pierce led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon roll call, there were 8 members present. Mayor Jones gave the oath of office to Joe Hoen, Kay Gathright and James Parker, Jimmie Lou Kirkpatrick was not present. This made 11 members present. Others in attendance were Brent Pinkerton, Attorney Bryan Chesshir, Larry Dunaway, Kimberly Green, Mark Dale, City Clerk Woodruff and other citizens.

Monica Clark made a motion to approve the minutes from December 27, 2016 with Andy Anderson making the motion to second. There were 11 yeas and 0 nays to approve all three sets of minutes.

Next Kimberly Green presented the financials and explained the extraordinary expenses for December 2016. With there being no questions in regards to financials Carol Mitchell made a motion to approve with Vivian Wright making the second. There were 11 yeas and 0 nays.

Dale Pierce had nothing to report out of the ordinary and that all was good with his department.

Larry Dunaway told the council that he did not have much to report either. He did state that he had purchased two Dodge Durango's from the County. He stated that Jason Morris was driving one and Mike Hale was driving one and that the trucks they had been driving were put in the fleet of work trucks. The total cost for both vehicles was \$4,800.00.

Mark Dale gave an update on the park. He stated that 5th & 6th grade basketball was under way and that most of the bathroom maintenance was nearly completed. He told the council that he had been talking to the Mayor about getting the city website up and having Heritage Computers build it. There is a meeting February 6 at the park to discuss this.

The only new business was Animal Control getting a new vehicle. Mayor Jones stated that he had a meeting that morning with the Mayors of the other cities and they had approved A/C budget. Mayor Jones stated that Seborn had purchased a new truck and he needed the approval of the council to finance it at Diamond Bank. Matt Smith made a motion to go to Diamond Bank and finance the Animal Control truck, a 2017 Chevrolet Colorado, in the amount of \$19,490.00, giving Mayor Billy Ray Jones and City Clerk Mary Woodruff authority to sign said loan. Joe Hoen made the second. In going around the table there were 11 yeas and 0 nays.


