

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF NASHVILLE,  
ARKANSAS  
November 12, 2021 12:00**

The city council of Nashville, Arkansas met in special session November 12, 2021 at noon. Alderman Nick Davis led in prayer; Mayor Billy Ray Jones led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Answering roll call were 7 Aldermen: Freddie Horne, Joe Hoen, Nick Davis, Monica Clark, Will Turley, Kay Gathright and Kathy Combs.

Public works director Larry Dunaway and Mayor Jones explained the budget shortfall and the need for increased revenue in the street department. The mayor explained that millage is the main way that revenue is brought in. He noted that raising it by 1 mill should generate about \$68,000. Dunaway also explained that he is decreasing some expenses in the budget.

Resolution 2021-11 A RESOLUTION TO LEVY THE CITY MILLAGE FOR 2021 TO BE COLLECTED IN 2022 was read.

Motion was made by Alderwoman Monica Clark and seconded by Freddie Horne to pass 2021-11 and designate the additional 1 mill as income for the street department. Motion passed 7-0.
