

ORDINANCE NO. 973

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE 2020 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE OF THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION, AND TO BE AMENDED INTO THE NASHVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 11.12, ELECTRICAL CODE.


WHEREAS, in the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Nashville, Arkansas, the City Council of Nashville, Ar. desires to adopt the 2020 edition of the National Electrical Code as published by the National Fire Protection Association.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. 11.12.01. Adoption of electrical code. There is hereby adopted for the City of Nashville for the purpose of establishing the minimum rules and regulations for the construction, alteration, removal, and maintenance of electric wiring and apparatus, including permits and penalties, that certain electric code known as the National Electric Code of the National Fire Protection Association, being particularly the 2020 edition thereof, and the whole thereof, save and except such portions as are hereinafter deleted, modified, or amended, of which not less than three (3) copies have been and now are filed in the office of the Clerk/Treasurer of the city and the same are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and the provisions thereof shall be controlling in the construction, alteration, maintenance or removal of all electric wiring and apparatus within the corporate limits of the city.


SECTION 2. All other sections of Chapter 11.12 of the Nashville Municipal Code will remain in full force and effect upon passage of this ordinance.
