

**NASHVILLE CITY COUNCIL  
MINUTES OF SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
January 12, 2023**

Nashville City Council met in a special called meeting January 12, 2023 at 12:00 noon. Mayor Larry Dunaway called the meeting to order. Jimmy Dale led the group in prayer; Mayor Dunaway led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Nine council members were present: Freddie Horne, Donna Harwell, Phil Jones, William Turley, Kay Gathright, Charles Pinkston, Herbert Turley, Kathy Combs and Jimmy Dale.

Mayor Dunaway started the meeting by swearing in Jimmy Dale into the council.

Fire chief Justin Thornton presented three different pumper trucks to the council. First option was a 2005 Spartan 1500/750 Pumper for the price of \$179,000. Option two was a 2017 Spartan Metro Star Custom Pumper for the price of \$450,000. Option three was a 2019 Sutphen Custom Rescue Pumper for the price of \$525,000. Thornton mention that they are going to trade in their rescue truck for the price of \$55,000 and also put down a \$125,000 down payment on truck option 3. William Turley made a motion for truck option three, the 2019 Sutphen pumper to be on a bid. Second by Herbert Turley. Motion passed with 5 yea's and 4 nays.

Mayor Dunaway read Resolution 2023-01. Resolution was to remove Billy Ray Jones and Carol Mitchell from any and all signature cards and add Lauren Hoen, city clerk and Justin Thornton, fire chief. Motion was made by Donna Harwell to pass Resolution 2023-01, second by Herbert. Motion passed.

Freddie Horne made a motion that before the city buys the new firetruck, he would like to see a finance report and how much the payments would be on the truck. Second by Jimmy Dale. Motion passed.
