

EMERGENCY CALLED MEETING
September 27, 2019

City of Nashville, City Council met on Friday, September 27 2019 at 12:00 noon in the City Hall Council Chamber to discuss the purchase of two new police cars. Presiding Officer Mayor Billy Ray Jones called the meeting to order and led the council in prayer, and Amy Marion led Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon roll call 9 members were present. Those absent were, Cathy Combs, James Parker and Mike Milum. Others in attendance were City Clerk Woodruff, Public Works Director Larry Dunaway and Nashville Leader Louie Graves.

Chief Amy Marion told the council with one of the backup cars not running another one down and in the shop and the third one needing a motor she had found two new vehicles already rigged out with the exception of radio's and cameras. The approximate cost for those items is around \$5,200.00 for both. Amy stated that the officers are putting about 20 hours a day on the current cars with the switching out at shift change and they were having to use the Resource Officers vehicle as well. She told them that both the Tahoe's were still under warranty as they were program/dealership demo show vehicles and each came with a 100,000 mile power train warranty. The Mayor stated that the vehicles would be paid for out of Equipment Replacement and that we are looking for an insurance check around \$35,000.00.

Freddie Horn made a motion to purchase both vehicles and Nick Davis made the second. The vote was unanimous.

With there being no further business Jimmie Lou made the motion to adjourn with Kay making the second. Meeting adjourned at 12:20
