

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
SEPTEMBER 24, 2018**

The City Council of the City of Nashville met on Monday, September 24, 2018 at 6:00 pm in the City Hall Council Chamber for the regular monthly meeting. Presiding Officer Mayor Billy Ray Jones called the meeting to order, Nick Davis led the prayer and Mayor Jones led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon roll call 11 members were present and Andy Anderson was absent. Others in attendance were Ty Baisliere, City Clerk Woodruff, Jonathon Canady (SW Arkansas Radio) Louie Graves (Nashville Leader), Kimberly Green, Finance Director, Larry Dunaway, Public Works Director and City Attorney Aaron Brasel. Monica Clark made a motion to approve the August minutes and Vivian Wright seconded. There were 11 years with Carol mentioning a typo that needed corrected.

Kimberly Green explained the extraordinary expenses for August. The largest one was out of Capital Outlay for \$37,680.00 of which we have already received \$30,000.00 back from the state. Carol Mitchell made a motion to accept financials with Jimmie Lou making the second. There were 11 years.

Elizabeth Fawcett with Wilf & Henderson presented the 2017 W&WW audit. She hit the high notes and stated that city is in sound financial shape.

Larry gave brief updates on all the projects and stated that everything is moving ahead.

Under new business budget workshop dates were set for November 5 and 19th. Applications will be taken until October 12 for the Chief of Police job and the week following there will be council and applicants interviews and hopefully a new chief will be appointed at the October 22nd council meeting.

With there being no further business James Parker made a motion to adjourn and Joe Hoen made the second. Meeting adjourned at 6:32pm.
