

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE  
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS  
JUNE 25, 2018**

The City Council of the City of Nashville met on Monday, June 25, 2018 at 6:00 pm in the City Hall Council Chamber for the regular monthly meeting. Presiding Officer Mayor Billy Ray Jones called the meeting to order, Nick Davis led the prayer and Mayor Jones led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon roll call 8 council members were present with Donna Harwell, Vivian Wright, Jimmie Lou Kirkpatrick and Mike Milum absent. Others in attendance were Louie Graves (Nashville Leader), Jonathon Canaday (SW Arkansas Radio) Finance Director Kimberly Green, Chief Dale Pierce and City Attorney Bryan Chesshir, City Attorney Aaron Brazel, Public Works Director Larry Dunaway, and Park Director Mark Dale. Joe Hoen made a motion to accept the minutes for the May 29th meeting and Carol Mitchell seconded. There were 8 yeas.

Kimberly Green explained the extraordinary expenses for May which included transfers, paving, culverts and maintenance. Kimberly stated that City sales tax from this time last year had increased by 3.9% and the County had decreased by 2.5%. With there being no discussion Andy Anderson made the motion to accept the financials for May and Carol Mitchell seconded. There were 8 yeas.

Next on the agenda was Larry Dunaway. Larry discussed the Waste Management contract again as it was tabled in May to discuss in June. There was no action taken on this matter so it will be addressed again at a later date.

Mark Dale spoke to the council and gave updates on the different activities that had been hosted at the park. He stated that there had been a great turn out for the Peach Blossom Festival that was co-hosted with the Chamber of Commerce. Mark also told the council that there had been several baseball and softball tournaments that had generated quite a bit of revenue. A copy of the Park Commission minutes were included for each council member.

Under new business the Mayor welcomed the representatives here for Husqvarna and told the council that ordinance numbers 944 and 945 needed approval for the company to continue forward. Bryan Chesshir read **Ordinance 944** which is the issuance of a **\$30,000,000.00 Industrial Development Bond**. Carol Mitchell made the motion to pass the ordinance and Kay Gathright made the second. There 8 yeas. Monica Clark made a motion to suspend the rules and put the ordinance on its final reading and Carol Mitchell made the second. There 8 yeas. James Parker made a motion for an emergency clause so the ordinance could go into effect immediately and Joe Hoen made the second. There were 8 yeas. Next Larry Dunaway read **Ordinance 945** which is the issuance of a **\$5,000,000.00 Industrial Development Bond**. Monica Clark made a motion to pass the ordinance and Joe Hoen made the second. There were 8 yeas. Carol Mitchell made a motion to suspend the rules and put the ordinance on its final reading and Monica Clark made the second, there 8 yeas. Then Carol Mitchell made a motion for an emergency clause to make the ordinance affective immediately and Monica Clark made the second. There were 8 yeas.

In going around the table there were a few items discussed with Larry and with there being no further business James Parker made a motion to adjourn and there were several seconds and the Mayor adjourned the meeting at 7:15pm.
