

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF  
THE CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS ON  
November 25, 2014**

The City Council of the City of Nashville met on Tuesday, November 25 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers.

Presiding Officer Mayor Billy Ray Jones called the meeting to order.

Jimmy Dale led the Council in prayer.

Mayor Jones led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag.

Clerk McDaniel was absent and PWD Dunaway helped with the order of the meeting.

On roll call 7 members answered as their names were called. Aldermen Brown, Smith, Harwell, Parker, and Milum were absent.

After a review of the minutes of the September council meeting, Alderwoman Clark made a motion to approve the minutes and Alderwoman Wright seconded. On roll call vote the motion passed with all yeas and no nays. (7-0)

Next Mayor Jones gave the financial report for Financial Director Dale. Mr. Dale left the following Extraordinary Expense report for October 2014 to be read:

There were no out of the ordinary expenses occurring in October. All departments continue to be cautious in their spending and the results are shown by the reports showing Revenues exceeding Expenditures several times this year. There was a \$10,000.00 transfer made to Street for operating expenses.

I need for the Council members to bring a copy of the Audit from Legislative audit for 2014 (yellow booklet) to the December meeting so it can be presented and accepted.

YTD the Wastewater Construction revenue has been \$4,308,569.00 and the expenses have been \$4,320,204.00.

Alderwoman Mitchell made a motion to accept the financial report for October and Alderwoman Kirkpatrick seconded. On roll call vote the motion passed with all yeas and no nays (7-0).

Next PWD Dunaway gave a report on the Wastewater Treatment Plant project. He said the weather has been good and it should be January when we get the plant started up.

The Water plant sludge ponds are getting cleaned out. One has been done and McCrary is working on the other one and it should be around two years before we have to do preventative maintenance again. McCrary is also working on the spillway repairs. He agreed to do the work for \$13,500 and we thought it was going to cost \$80,000.00 so it has worked out very well, stated Dunaway.

Next, Park Director Nikki Cherry gives her report on Park activities. She stated the Holiday in the Park will be December 1, 2014 right after the parade.

Under new business, Resolution No 2014-07 was postponed until the December meeting. Mayor Jones discussed giving all employees a 2% raise also changing insurance from Municipal Health Benefit to Blue Cross Blue Shield.

Alderman Anderson motioned to accept the September financials and Alderwoman Wright seconded. On roll call vote the motion passed with all yeas and no nays. (9-0)

Alderman Anderson made a motion to adjourn and Alderwoman Kirkpatrick seconded. Mayor Jones called the meeting adjourned at 6:21 p.m.
