

ORDINANCE NO. 872

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE NASHVILLE ZONING ORDINANCE
AFFECTING BILLBOARDS WITHIN THE NASHVILLE CITY LIMITS**

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission has deemed it necessary to amend the zoning regulations concerning bill board, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held to consider the input from all concerned citizens and to comply with the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance with respect to revisions in the textual provisions of the Ordinance, now


THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF NASHVILLE:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 434, adopted April 7, 1975, the Nashville Zoning Ordinance, Article V, Section 2 entitled "All Districts" shall be amended by adding the following paragraphs, to-wit:

- (10) Billboards shall not be erected or otherwise fixed to any pole, tree, stone, fence, building, structure, or any object within the city limits of Nashville, Arkansas. For the purpose of this Ordinance, a bill board is defined as:
- (a) An advertisement in written or pictorial format that describes services or information about a business other than one on the same property as the billboard.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
