The City Council of the City of Nashville met on Tuesday, November 26, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers.

Presiding Officer Mayor Billy Ray Jones called the meeting to order.

Financial Director Jimmy Dale led the Council in prayer.

Mayor Jones then led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag.

On roll call 7 members answered as their names were called. Alderwoman Gathright, Alderwoman Kirkpatrick, Alderwoman Clark, Alderwoman Harwell, and Alderman Brown were absent.
