

ORDINANCE NO. 976

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 617, SEC 1 OF THE NASHVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 11.16.07, FIRE INSPECTION FEES.

WHEREAS, the Nashville Fire Department provides businesses and residents with comprehensive fire inspections annually, upon request, or deemed necessary, and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to set a uniformed schedule for fees providing the services,


BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS


SECTION 1: The Nashville Municipal Code, chapter 11.16.07, Fire Inspection Fees, to read as follows:

The fire inspection fee is set at \$50.00 per residents and \$75.00 per business. Industrial facilities and healthcare facilities, not including outpatient clinics are set at \$150.00. The Senior Citizens Center, Educational facilities, Churches, and Government buildings are to be exempt from inspection fees. Revenues are to be deposited into the Nashville General Fund with 75% being paid to the Fire Department, and 25% remaining in the General Fund.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is to be in full force and in effect upon its passage by the City Council.
